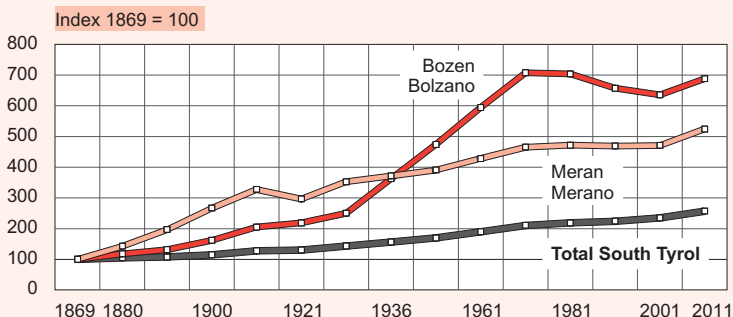

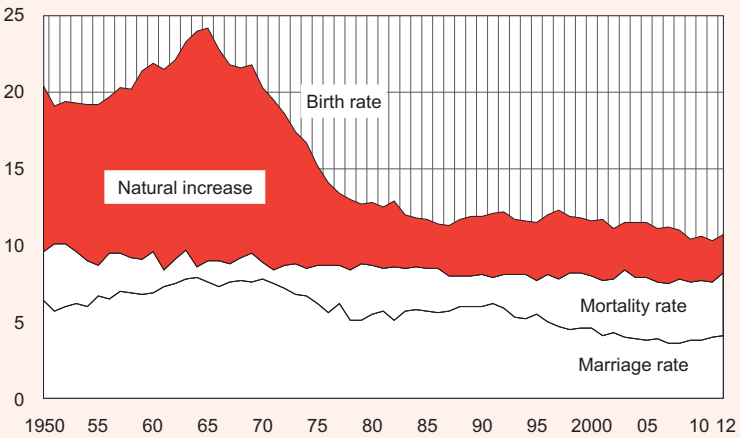

Migration balance by source and destination area - 2010

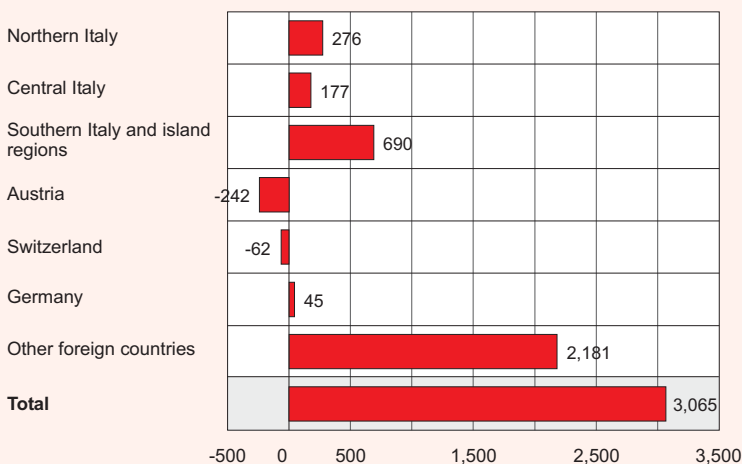

Students of nursery, primary, lower and upper secondary schools - school years 1970/71-2012/13

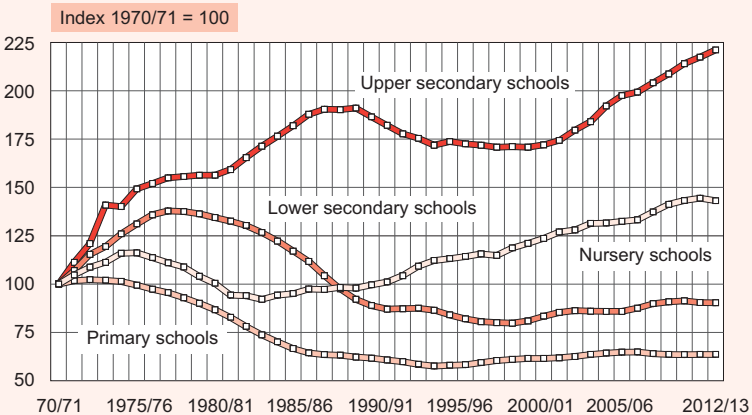

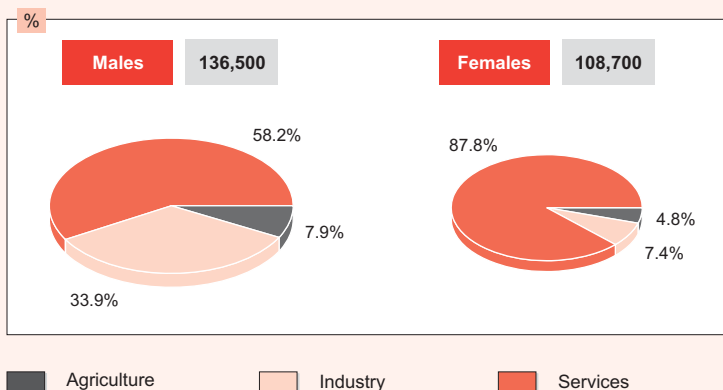

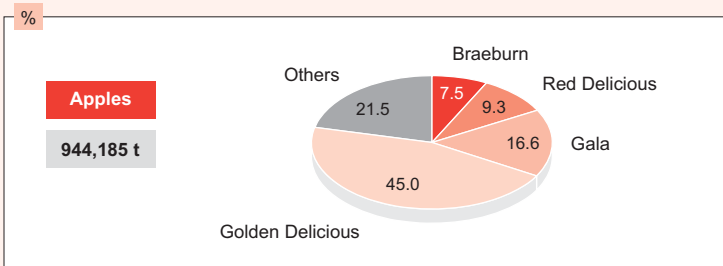

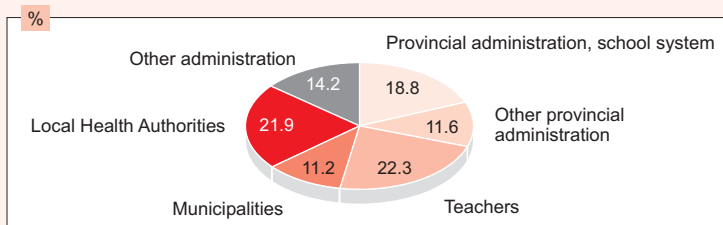
